

Saint Maria Goretti High School "Formal Dress" Guidelines

FOR THE LADIES: Acceptable attire is elegant, tasteful, and modest. Dresses <u>must not</u> be cut below the bust line in the front (including cut-outs below the bust line) have the midriff exposed (including front and sides) be cut below the ribcage in the back be shorter than, or have a slit that exceeds, 2 inches above the knee utilize see-through fabrics below the bust line reveal undergarments

FOR THE GENTLEMEN: Acceptable attire is a tuxedo (or dress suit), dress shirt, and tie, worn with dress shoes.

Casual clothing is not permitted. This includes—but is not limited to—t-shirts, aloha shirts, polo shirts, shorts, baggy pants, jeans, sweats, baseball caps, bandanas, athletic or casual shoes, sandals, and slippers. Undergarments must not be visible.

All Goretti gentlemen who are in attendance must be in compliance with the daily school dress code with regard to hair length, facial hair, and earrings.

PLEASE NOTE: A student's attire must be in compliance with these guidelines in order for the student to enter the event. If the student's attire cannot be corrected to comply with these guidelines, he or she will not be permitted to enter the event, and a parent will be called to take the student home. No refund will be given.
